

Pickleball Club Board Election FAQs

- The Board unanimously approved the procedures below for the LOW Pickleball Board's term of office and upcoming election process:
 - Physical year is from 9/1 to 8/31.
 - Members of the Board must be resident and available to attend Club meetings 12 months of the year.
 - Board term is three years. A member can serve two consecutive terms.
 - On years that an opening(s) occur, a call for candidates will be sent to Club members on July 1. A member **self nominates** either online or by hard copy no later than July 30. No nominations of OTHERS will be accepted since they may not want to serve and make this long-term commitment.
 - On 8/1, the voting will open (both a box in the Community Center for hard copy votes or online votes will be accepted). Online votes will be printed and added to the voting box. Voting will close on 8/20. Each Club member is allowed one vote for each board opening.
 - At the regular Board meeting the last Wednesday of August, the votes will be calculated and the newly elected Board members will be announced on 9/1.
 - The new Board members will take office at the Board meeting the last Wednesday in September.
 - The new Board will elect the Club officers at the September meeting.
 - This year, the Club has four members completing their term (John Cavanaugh, Sandy Loudon, Tena Marangi and Andy Siegel). Mark Warner stated he may need to resign from the Board. He will make this decision by 7/30 so we know how many seats are open for the election.
